

## **Avedik Isahakyan (1875-1957)**



The house museum in Yerevan, located at 20 Zarubyan Street, is where Isahakyan spent the last 5 years of his life and which was converted into a museum in 1963.

The museum consists of his workroom, which displays his desk; his bedroom and living room, including the sofa made especially

for him; his private library of over 5000 volumes; the last books he read, his pen, glasses and worry-beads. The total number of exhibition items is close to 13,000.

The various exhibition halls focus on different periods of his life. One of the paintings in the living room is a charcoal portrait of Isahakyan made by Martiros Saryan.
