

Hovannes Tumanyan (1869-1923)

The house museum in the village of Dsegh (Lori Marz) is the ancestral home of the poet/writer Hovannes Tumanyan. In 1969, on the occasion of the

100th anniversary of the writer's birth, a new two-storey building was built to house materials related to Tumanyan's life and works, including his personal items, documents, manuscripts, and sketches. There are about 300 exhibition pieces.



A small chapel adjoining the house is where Tumanyan's heart is



buried. The museum was managed for 59 years by Tumanyan's niece, Armenouhi Tumanyan.
