

Hovhannes Hovhannesian (1864-1929)

Teacher, poet, and translator Hovhannes Hovhannesian's house museum is in Etchmiadzin, where he was born and lived with his eight children. The museum was established by his daughter. The collection features photographs and artifacts displayed within the museum; his statue stands in the courtyard.



Among the collection is an upright piano on display in the living room which Komitas, a student of Hovhannesian, had played, and a tribute, displayed in a glass case, from another of his students, Avedik Isahakyan. His desk, which remains as he had it on the

day he died, still has a book by Ivan Turgenev on it.
